Upon arrival, I made contact with Officer Mark Cassady from PAWS who advised me his agency was contacted by an unidentified caller who reported seeing what appeared to be a deceased dog lying in the yard of the residence listed in this report. Cassady advised that when he arrived he checked the yard and found two dogs lying in the yard west of the house. A closer check by Cassady confirmed both dogs were deceased and decomposing. Additionally, Cassady located a live cat inside the house which was removed for safe keeping.

Cassady was able to contact the owner who told him his daughter, Michelle Mackee, was responsible for caring for the animals. Cassady was told Mackee would be en route to the scene.

I conducted an inspection of the scene and found two deceased dogs in the yard west of the house. The first dog appeared to be a long hair husky mix and was lying in the yard, was bloated with flesh eating insects around the openings of the body. The second dog also appeared to be a long hair husky mix with a choke chain collar around its neck and was attached to a dog house by a cable. The cable was wrapped around the dog house as well as entangled in the legs of the dog house. The dog was lying under the dog house and appeared to be in a more advanced stage of decomposition. The body was no longer bloated and the flesh eating insects were no longer present. There was a metal wash tub near the dogs, however; it was dry. The wash tub would hold approximately 15 - 20 gallons of water. I took photographs of the scene and entered them into evidence.

Michelle Mackee did not arrive at the scene prior to my arrival.

The scene was turned over to Officer Cassady and the investigation continues.

On 7/16/10, I made contact with Dee Thompson, PAWS Director, who provided a copy of the necropsy of the two deceased dogs which was performed by Dr Mark Soroken DVM, PAWS Staff Veterinarian. Dr Soroken's report states there were no signs of gunshot or other penetration wounds. During the examination, Dr Soroken noted the hair could be easily pulled out, there was blood in the oral cavities and free blood in the abdominal cavity. Additionally, the internal organs gave the impression of being exposed to extreme heat. Specimens were taken from the liver, small intestines, stomach, and kidney. Dr Soroken's overall impression was the dogs died from exposure to extreme heat and listed the cause of death as heat stroke.

Mackee was read her Miranda rights, per prepared text. She waived her rights by signing a rights form and agreed to fill out a sworn statement. In her statement she advised, she had been looking after the animals for her parents and everytime she went by they had food and water. She said on the days she could not make it her parents home she had a friend go by and check on the animals. She also stated she started to have vehicle problems and could not make it to her parents house some days. She said her parents knew about her vehicles problems and the fact she could drive because of her license being suspended.

I will forward this information to Deputy Peters. This ends my involvment with this case.

[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE

On 7/13/10, I responded to 3246 Little Silver Rd, Crestview, to assist an Okaloosa County Animal Control Officer. Upon arrival, I made contact with Officer Mark Cassady who stated he responded to conduct a welfare check of the dogs at this residence. Officer Cassady found two dogs deceased in the yard and a live cat inside the house. The dog carcasses found were lying inside the fenced yard with no water available. One dog carcass was lying in the open with no signs of trauma. The second dog carcass had a choke chain (collar) on and was attached to a cable. The cable was tangled around a dog house and the dog carcass was lying under the house. Both dog carcasses were in advanced stages of decomposition.

It appeared no one was living at the residence.

Office Cassady contacted the property owner who identified the former resident as Michelle Mackee. The property owner, who is living in Arkansas, stated Mackee is responsible for the care and welfare of the animals.

A necropsy was performed by Dr Mark Soroken DVM, PAWS Staff Veterinarian. Dr Soroken determined the cause of death was heat stroke.

DS Kyle Lowery interviewed Michelle Mackee (suspect) who provided in a post Miranda statement that on Sunday, 7/11/10, she checked on the animals and they had sufficient food and water. Mackee also stated the dog that was tied to the house was untangled on 7/11/10 when she was at the scene.

Based on my investigation, the decomposition of the animals and the report provided by Dr Mark Soroken, I have reason to believe and do believe the defendant, Michelle Lynn Mackee, did violate F.S.S. 828.12 (2)/Animal Cruelty Causing Death Pain and Suffering and F.S.S. 828.13/Animal Abandonment.

This incident occurred in Okaloosa County, Florida.

On Tuesday, June 29, 2010, at approximately 1514 hours, I responded to 4262 Sam Jordan Rd. for a report of an agency assist.

Upon arrival, I made contact with the witnesses; Okaloosa County Panhandle Animal Welfare Society (PAWS) animal control officers, Mr. Mark Cassady and Mr. Colin Hall.

Ms. Cassady verbally stated he had responded to the aforementioned property the day prior and posted a notice of intent to remove the animals confined on the property from within the property. Mr. Cassady further stated during that visit he observed there was no food or water on the premises for the animals to consume. He also stated upon his return back to the residence he observed that it did not appear that anyone had visited since he last left. Therefore, because of health and safety precautions, and because he had cause to believe the animals had been abandoned by their owner(s) he was going to seize the animals from the property. During the confiscation operation a total of sixteen cats, two kittens and four dogs were removed from the property. While doing so he also observed the skeletal remains of five animals; two inside the home and three outside the home.

Mr. Cassady completed a sworn, signed, affidavit of complaint corroborating his verbal account of events.

Mr. Hall also completed a sworn, signed, which corroborated Mr. Cassady's verbal account of events. However, Mr. Hall further added he observed one animal skull and one skeleton inside a chain link pen on the side of the home, and two more skeletons inside a separate chain link pen, also adjacent to the home. Inside the home he further observed two additional skeletons lying amid a floor covered with feces.

During my interaction with Mr. Cassady and Mr. Hall I observed four dogs inside the front yard, three were running freely and one was chained to a dog house. There was no food visible inside the yard and the only source of water was an overturned five gallon bucket and a plastic beverage cooler. The five gallon bucket was almost empty of water while the plastic cooler was filled to capacity. The water inside both containers was dirty and appeared to have been accumulated rain water. Adjacent to the side of the home and confined inside a closed chain link pen I observed seven cats, one skull and one partial animal skeleton. Inside a separate pen I adjacent to the front yard of the home I observed one more cat and two additional skeleton remains. Mr. Cassady and Mr. Hall were unable to catch that cat and set and left an animal trap on scene instead. Furthermore, inside a pen at the rear of the home I also observed seven additional cats. From the home's exterior I observed another cat sitting on the windowsill of the window inside the home. A check of the entryway doors revealed them to be unlocked. Mr. Cassady, Mr. Hall and I made entry into the home to confiscate the remaining animals. Upon making entry into the home there was an overwhelming stench of feces and urine and I observed all the doors and windows were closed and there were large quantities feces and trash scattered throughout the home. A check of the interior of the home revealed there were four additional cats and two kittens inside. And, while inside the home I further observed the skeletal remains of two additional animals intermingled amongst the feces.

During my investigation I did not observe any food sources anywhere on the property, and the water sources that were contained therein appeared to be unfit for consumption.

Additionally, during my investigation a Caucasian female later identified as the suspect; Mrs. Elizabeth Moore entered onto the property. Mrs. Moore's identity was confirmed via her state of Florida issued driver's license and she verbally stated she was the home's owner and the owner of the aforementioned animals.

I detained Mrs. Moore and advised her of her rights, per, Miranda, via prepared text. Mrs. Moore verbally acknowledged her rights and consented to answer questions.

Mrs. Moore further stated she had been breeding the cats, but due to the economy she and her husband lost their business, lost the home, and turned off its power because they had no money. She further stated they left the home approximately two months prior, but she would return to the property every couple of days to provide the animals with food and water and the situation just spiraled out of control.

Mrs. Moore completed a sworn, signed, voluntary statement corroborating her verbal account of events.

Deputy Sheriff Ginny Johnson responded to assist and took digital photographs of the crime scene.

A compact disk containing the photographs was placed into evidence and copies of the photographs were attached to the case file.

Based upon my investigation and my observation of the dilapidated condition of the home and the large quantity of feces contained within, it did not appear that the quantity of trash and feces inside the home could have accumulated to such a degree within the two-month time frame Mrs. Moore alleged the animals had been left unattended. I had probable cause to believe and did believe Mrs. Moore committed the offenses of animal cruelty and confining animals without food and water, therefore, I informed and placed her under arrest.

I transported Mrs. Moore to the Okaloosa County Jail for booking purposes and released her into the custody of jail personnel.

There were no further investigative actions taken by this deputy and this case was closed with an arrest.

Witness #1 stated because of health and safety precautions, and because he had cause to believe the animals had been abandoned by their owner(s) he was going to seize the animals from the property. During the confiscation operation a total of sixteen cats, two kittens and four dogs were removed from the property. While doing so he also observed the skeletal remains of five animals; two inside the home and three outside the home.

Witness #2 stated he observed one animal skull and one skeleton inside a chain link pen on the side of the home, and two more skeletons inside a separate chain link pen, also adjacent to the home. While inside the home he further observed two additional skeletons lying amid a floor covered with feces.

Post Miranda, the defendant stated she had been breeding the cats, but due to the economy, she and her husband lost their business, lost the home, and turned off its power because they had no money. She further stated they left the home approximately two months prior, but she would return to the property every couple of days to provide the animals with food and water and the situation just spiraled out of control.

Based upon the aforementioned information I have probable cause to believe and do believe the defendant; Elizabeth Moore committed the offenses in violation of F.S.S. 828.12.2, cruelty to animals, to wit; she did intentionally commit acts upon animals which resulted in the cruel death or infliction of unnecessary pain or suffering, and F.S.S. 828.13, unlawful abandonment or confinement of an animal, to wit; she did unlawfully and knowingly impound or confine animals and failed to supply the animals during such confinement with sufficient quantities of good and wholesome food and water.

These offenses did occur in Okaloosa County, Florida, where I am a sworn law enforcement officer.
